LOCAL VOLUNTEER EFFORT BREAKS GROUND ON NEW HOME FOR DESERVING FAMILY

Project is in Urgent Need of Volunteers, Materials and Money to make "HEAVEN HOUSE" a REALITY

A Kickoff Foundation Celebration is being held on **Saturday, October 3, 2009 at 3pm** and the **media & public are invited**

Local citizens, businesses and churches partnering with **Hometown Heroes** have come together in an all volunteer effort to build a new home for a special **Brookfield family**, the **O'Briens**. The **Heaven House project** is an opportunity for the community to come together and give back to a family that has provided a forever home for countless children the state's foster system deemed "unadoptable" and provide the family more room to help care for more children.

The family currently consists of 19 people; 2 parents, 3 biological children, 10 adopted children/process of adoption and 4 foster/other children being helped. The current home is in need of repair and is not large enough to accommodate more children. The new home will be handicap accessible and provide needed room so the family can take in more children.

Ground for the new home was broken on Friday, August 28, 2009 next to the O'Brien's existing home. The foundation is up and the first floor is capped off. To mark the successful beginning of the project and to make the wider community aware of the Heaven House effort, we are holding a **Foundation Celebration on October 3, 3pm** that the **media and public is encouraged to attend**. The O'Brien family will be on hand as will Heaven House organizers, **Hometown Heroes founder, Jim Kacmarcik** and **Green Bay Packer running back #25 Ryan Grant**. They will all be available for interview after the program.
